Yorubaland Health Initiative (YHI) Update

- Earlier this year, the YHI committee provided its final report on our YHI activities in Nigeria. The association has successfully implemented three health initiatives in various Yorubaland States, including:
 - The Diabetes initiative in Ibadan, Oyo State:
 - The Tuberculosis initiative in Lagos State; and
 - The High Blood Pressure (HBP) initiative in Ekiti and Ondo States
- The latest completed HBP initiative involved the provision of HBP equipments and medications to two hospitals to provide free clinical blood pressure screening sessions for the communities within their vicinity.
